REPORT OF THE DIRECTOR OF NATIONAL PROJECTS

4/03 THE NEW ENVIRONMENTAL ECONOMY PROGRAMME - APPROVAL OF PROJECTS (A.92748/KJP)

The Sub-Committee were requested to approve two project applications where the level of grant sought exceeded £8,000.

It was reported that the total costs of the projects had changed as follows:

Project 1: Lower Hurst Events, Lower Hurst Farm near Hartington.

Total cost: £29,031 Total grant to be offered: £10,949

Project 2: Kath and Ada's Shippon, Adders Green, Quarnford

Total cost: £52,125 Total grant to be offered: £20,000

Confirmation was awaited from the Government Office for the East Midlands (GOEM) that they will be reimbursing the Authority the cost of the grants.

RESOLVED:

That, subject to confirmation from GOEM, grant aid be offered to the projects described in the report.

- 1. Lower Hurst Events. 45% grant up to a maximum £10,949
- 2. Kath and Ada's Shippon. 50% grant up to a maximum of £20,000

All grants to be subject to the standard conditions of the NEE Programme.
