<u>Proposal</u>

1. This report requests the Authority to consider the appointment of Members to attend this year's Association of National Park Authorities' Workshop with the theme "Climate Change in National Parks".

2. **RECOMMENDATION:**

- 2. That attendance at the Workshop be an approved duty for the payment of travel and subsistence allowances.

Policy/Legal Background

- 3. Each year the Association of National Park Authorities holds a Workshop for National Park Authority Members and Officers. The themes chosen are current topics that are relevant to all authorities that can provide an opportunity for discussion and sharing of ideas and best practice.
