Detail on Progress Towards BAP Targets

Woodland Habitats

- *Upland Ashwoods:* Conservation target of 70% ancient woodland met, and 100 ha nonancient exceeded (330 ha). Restoration target of 50% exceeded (72%).
- Upland Oak/Birchwoods: Conservation target of 300 ha ancient woodland not met (112 ha), and 100 ha non-ancient exceeded (396 ha). Restoration target of 80 ha exceeded (334 ha). Expansion target of 200 ha not met (179 ha).
- *Wet Woodlands:* The majority occurs as small elements of oak-birch wood so the resource is not well defined.
- *Parkland & Veteran Trees:* The conservation target for parkland has been achieved. The veteran tree resource is data deficient, however, the Derbyshire Wildlife Trust's Great Trees of Derbyshire project will aid future delivery.

Grassland Habitats

- Limestone Dales: Conservation target of 100% favourable condition in SSSI by 2005 (92.95% achieved); non-SSSI target of 80% in favourable management by 2005 (16% achieved).
 Restoration target of 30 ha by 2010 not met. Expansion target reliant on mineral restoration progress and opportunities unclear.
- Hay Meadows: Conservation target of 100% favourable condition in SSSI by 2005 (79% achieved); non-SSSI target of 50% in favourable management by 2005 (14% achieved). Restoration target of 500 ha by 2010 was over-ambitious, 32 ha has been achieved. Expansion target of 10 ha by 2010 not yet met.
- Unimproved Pastures: Conservation target of 100% favourable condition in SSSI by 2005 (76% achieved); non-SSSI target of 50% in favourable management by 2005 (21% achieved). Restoration progress unclear. Expansion progress unclear.
- *Rough Grazing:* Conservation target of 30% in favourable management by 2005 exceeded for SSSI (57%) and non-SSSI (69%). Restoration target of 50 ha by 2010 (15 ha achieved). Expansion targets being addressed through Planning casework and Vision Project.
- Rush Pasture: Conservation target of 50% in favourable condition by 2005 met for SSSI (52%) and exceeded for non-SSSI (70%). Restoration target of 100 ha by 2005 exceeded (136 ha). Expansion target unrealistic.
- Lead Rakes: Conservation target of 100% favourable condition in SSSI by 2005 (96.5% achieved on areas surveyed), non-SSSI target of 50% in agreement by 2005 (52.5% of surveyed sites). Restoration target of 25 ha by 2005 (4 ha achieved). Expansion target of 15 ha by 2010, some unquantified progress through development control casework and Vision Project.
- *Limestone Heath:* Conservation target of 100% in favourable management by 2005, not met for SSSI (2.5% achieved) or non-SSSI (66.5%). Restoration target of 40 ha by 2010 not met. Expansion target not met.

Wetland Habitats

- *River Corridor Habitats:* Data deficient due to difficulties in defining resource and issues with partner engagement. Conservation target for key rivers and streams (SSSI units) in favourable condition by 2010 (23.7% achieved). Conservation target of 30% favourable condition in important wetlands by 2005 (83.6% achieved on SSSI, 42.5% non-SSSI). Restoration target difficult to quantify, small-scale projects completed. Expansion target not quantified, 10 ha achieved.
- *Ponds:* Conservation targets poorly quantified, 1212 ponds (approximately 33%) are on land covered by an agreement. Target for 50% of highest importance ponds in management (45.3% achieved). Restoration target poorly quantified, 14 ponds restored. Expansion target of 20 ponds by 2003 (34 achieved by 2006).

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Moorland Habitats

- *Blanket Bog:* Conservation target of 100% management on all favourable SSSI habitat by 2003 (99% achieved). Conservation target of 23% favourable condition in SSSI by 2005 (51% achieved). Restoration target of 3000 ha by 2010 (3075 ha achieved).
- Heather Moorland: Conservation target 100% favourable condition in SSSIs (52% achieved) and 50% non-SSSI (46% in agreement). Conservation target of 100% management on all favourable SSSI habitat by 2005 (97% achieved). Restoration target 3500 ha by 2010 (1077 ha achieved). Expansion target of 100 ha by 2010 (6+ ha achieved).

Species

- *Water Vole:* Habitat management target of 50% important sites achieved. Restoration of sites underway.
- *Curlew:* Habitat management target of 50% breeding sites into management by 2005 (88% moorland, 33% farmland achieved). Population target for increase awaiting survey data.
- *Lapwing:* Habitat management target of 50% breeding sites into management by 2005 (82.5% moorland, 46.5% farmland achieved). Population target for increase awaiting survey data.
- *Twite:* Habitat management on 100% feeding sites by 2005 (71% achieved). Habitat target for 20% increase in feeding sites by 2010 (some progress made).
- *White-clawed Crayfish:* Habitat targets not met largely due to crayfish plague. Population target addressed through reintroduction scheme results unclear.
- Appleyard's Feather-moss: No longer considered separate species, so dropped from BAP.
- Derbyshire Feather-moss: Conservation measures achieved by EN.
