APPENDIX 1: Brief for Member Task Team on review of governance

- 1. To review the current formal governance structures and processes and propose 'fit for purpose' structures and decision making processes to meet expected outcomes. This to include a review of:
 - The size of the Authority
 - The size and type of committees
 - The conduct of Authority meeting and committees
 - The nature of reports required by Members
- 2. To review the extent of delegation of decision making to staff and make proposals for further delegation.
- 3. To suggest ways to increase member participation in ambassadorial, advocacy and facilitation roles with communities and with stakeholders
- 4. To feed into the Member Task Team on member learning and development any issues for member development arising from the recommendations of this task team
- 5. To review costs associated with governance

Expected outcomes:

- 1. Reduction in time spent in formal committees by Members and senior staff
- 2. Reduction in the resources spent to support formal committee structures and decision making processes
- 3. The ambassadorial, advocacy and facilitation role of Members within communities and with stakeholders is strengthened with Members more visible in the community
- 4. Increased satisfaction gained by Members, staff and the public from the way business is conducted
- 5. Members who attend a high proportion of meetings and have skills and capacity to play a full role on the Authority
- 6. Leaner governance structures
