

Objectives for Green Lanes

Heritage routes connect the access of today with discovering the use of the past.

Conservation routes connect people with nature for its study and understanding.

Community routes connect communities with their wider area for the well-being of residents and visitors.

Recreational routes form part of a promoted trail or an integral link to wider access for enjoyment, escape, or adventure.

People Objectives

- Reduce impact of use on local community
- Improve amenity and safety for route users
- Promote responsible use
- Encourage voluntary action
- Provide for exploration and escape
- Allow for the study of nature

Route Objectives

- Improve condition of route
- Maintain the character of the route
- Enhance the heritage features of the route
- Clarify legal status and/or line of the route
- Remove barriers to accessibility
- Integrate with access and rights of way network

Area Objectives

- Protect the environment of the area
- Enhance the biodiversity and wildlife connectivity of the route
- Minimise illegal use onto adjacent land
- Prevent deviation from the route
