Thornbridge Hall Estate Drainage

Ordnance Survey Map via PDNP is the base document

Lakes highlighted in blue

Drainage lines on the map are black dots with a circle around them

Drainage lines that we know about that are not on the map are red dots

Open waterways that we know about that are not on the map are red lines

Notes

- A) Water comes underneath the railway embankment into tanks underneath the Old Brewery, then on into the Bamboo Garden, Koi Lake and Large South Lake. According to the drawing the water seems to go back up hill to the old sewage farm, but it does not.
- B) Water comes under the Hall via two large tanks in the inner courtyard and down to Large South Lake. This is missing from the map
- C) Water enters at Folly Gates via a drain, but there are also multiple open waterways entering from the road.
- D) Sinkhole in the woodland with a drain to Bear Lake, the drain was missing from the drawing
- E) Sinkhole in the woodland with a drain to Bear Lake, the drain was missing from the drawing
- F) Junction of water from sources A & C, which we repaired years ago and which goes to South Lake
- G) Water from Longstone Lane that emerges in the woodland and flows into Small South Lake, which then drains under the drive to Large South Lake
- H) South Lake drains into an open stream that then goes under South Lodge and the road, before emerging as a stream on the other side of the A6020

The sewage drain is omitted, but could be added as we know where it goes.
