I think the HMRC has made this something companies are supposed to declare with Companies house, (https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/environmental-reporting-guidelines-including-mandatory-greenhouse-gas-emissions-reporting-guidance)but I can't seem to find this information for the once a week quarry (Natural Stone Sales Ltd). I imagine as they function within the National Park that you have this information to hand. Under freedom of information, I request to see a copy please.</p> <p>RESPONSE 05/10/2022 - The Peak District National Park Authority is the Mineral Planning Authority (MPA) responsible for operations permitted under the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 at Once-A-Week Quarry. There is no requirement under the Act, and neither does national or local planning policy stipulate that quarry operators must report 'CO2 ratings' or emissions to their respective MPA. As such, I'm afraid the National Park Authority, as MPA, does not hold the information that you have requested. Having looked at the guidance referenced in your email, I note that companies in scope of the legislation must include their energy and carbon information in the Directors' Report as part of their annual filing obligations. It could be, for instance, procured directly (without being called off from a framework agreement), or could be itself a notice of the establishment of a framework agreement.
