Standing Orders provide opportunities for Authority members to submit items for consideration at meetings of the Authority by submitting motions, questions and providing feedback from meetings of outside bodies.

This document provides details of the deadlines for submissions². These are set according to the timescales set out in Standing Orders, which reflect the statutory requirements that determine how and when we publish agendas for meetings of the Authority.
