Longstone Edge - Review of Old Mineral Permissions

I have been asked by the Authority's Minerals Team to write to you in respect of your request for an extension of time to provide the information requested by the Authority to enable the Authority to adopt an up-to-date screening opinion in relation to the Longstone Edge ROMP.

The Authority has been asked to agree a further extension of time by Bleaklow Industries Ltd in respect of the same issue and we have agreed to give them an extension until 31 March 2009.

In the circumstances we feel that it is appropriate to grant Glebe Mines Ltd a similar extension. We therefore agree to give your company an extension of time until 31 March 2009 for provision of the information requested in our letter to you of 12 August 2008. The matter can be reviewed as necessary at that time.

Please note, however, that the extension of time is without prejudice to the Authority's need to be satisfied that Glebe Mines Ltd are indeed an applicant. We have raised this issue with counsel and his advice is that mere ownership of a mineral vein does not mean that Glebe are an applicant. Although Glebe have stated that they have "taken over" the application, you have not set out the legal basis by which you claim to have done this nor provided evidence for it. I would be grateful, therefore, if you could respond further to this issue at an early stage.
